We currently are waiting on the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be executed among FCC, GA SHPO, and Columbia County to resolve the adverse effect associated with couple towers. Once the MOA has been executed, we should be receiving our finding of no significant impact (FONSI) from Department of Commerce to start construction. Board of Commissioners declared 18 firms qualified to perform the services required by the County for the Broadband Fiber Optic Cable Installation project. Board of Commissioners declared 13 firms qualified to perform the services required by the County for the Broadband Tower construction project. Released Bid# 2010-038: Installation of Fiber Optic Cable – Phase I to the 18 qualified vendors approved by the Board of Commissioners. Phase I project is approximately 26.19 miles of cable and 23.25 miles of conduit with no inside plant construction. Sixty-one (61) fiber route miles of staking and engineering has been completed during this quarter and three (3) railroad crossing permits have been submitted to CSX Transportation.
