Winter weather continued to delay in ground project construction. Matching discussion with Federal Program officer ongoing concerning use of Program Revenue. Reference 2e. (construction permits) An access road dispute has occurred between the land owner of the First Step leased ground for the tower site and an adjacent land owner. The land owner asserts that a portion of the

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access road crosses his land. This access road has been in use for over 20 years and this issue has just come up as part of the Conditional Use Permit process. Latah County added as a stipulation of the grant of the Conditional Use Permit, that First Step resolve the land access dispute between the parties. The parties are negotiating between themselves and a resolution is expected during Q2.
