During the last quarter the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the construction of the Middle Mile Digital Micro Wave (DMW) sites was released, the proposals evaluated, and price agreements are being finalized. The Governor approved and certified the project and it has been posted on the State of NM website. The Baseline Project Plan was approved, along with the Budget Amendment and the Six Month Budget. The New Mexico Office of Recovery and Reinvestment (NMORR) approved the release of all funds for the project. Three term positions have been established and are in the Governor's office for approval. It is expected that these positions will be hired within the next four to six weeks. The Department of Information Technology Secretary has been designated as the Principal Investigator. The extension was approved for conducting the Environmental Assessments and submission of an Overlap Map. The required Overlap Map was submitted for review and approval prior to March 1, 2011. The State is waiting on the approval for the sole source request for contacting general counsel. Three contracts have been negotiated and signed for conducting the Environmental Assessments on the fifty-nine DMW sites. A fourth contract is in the signature process for conducting the assessments on the fourteen 700MHz Long Term Evolution sites. All site lease agreements are being reviewed for notification requirements and any restrictions that may apply.

Contracting process delayed the execution of the contracts to perform EA analysis activities. Developing the four EA contracts impacted the development of the Price Agreements and formal announcement of the award. New staff, a change in government administration, and a delay in the appointment of key government personnel further delayed activities. Completion of the feasibility study is included in one of the EA contracts, and while not completed during Q3, will be completed early in Q4.
