During the next quarter, NebraskaLink will continue working with our consultant on the Environmental Assessment. This will include contacting all agencies in regard to our proposed route to ensure we will be in compliance. Our anticipated cost for this is \$21,198.

NebraskaLink will work on the detailed design of the fiber route and optical and electronic transport equipment necessary for Phase 1 of our project, which includes 165 miles of new fiber construction. Our anticipated cost for this is \$60,555.

NebraskaLink will work on our detailed OSP staking (mapping only) of Phase 1 for the fiber route. The anticipated cost for this is \$98,175.

NebraskaLink will conduct an OSP RFP process to select one or more Engineering / Construction firms to execute NebraskaLink's Phase 1 construction. Vendor(s) will be selected and begin Professional Engineering services. Estimated spend \$36,403.

NebraskaLink will purchase land for (1) hut location. Anticipated cost \$15,000.
