1. Please describe significant project accomplishments completed during this quarter (600 words or less).

During this quarter several significant activities have taken place to assist us in completing the Building Community Capacity through Broadband initiative in a timely fashion.

The environmental assessment was completed and submitted to the National Telecommunications and Information Administration on January 27, 2011. The firm of Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. led the environmental assessment process and during the quarter helped us continue providing information in each of the demonstration communities: Wausau, Platteville, Superior and the Chippewa Valley Region. In addition, the firm contacted all of the necessary parties to inform them of our effort and ensure compliance, and we had meetings with Wisconsin departments of Natural Resources and Transportation.

Statewide and local demonstration community partners continued monthly strategic planning meetings during the quarter. The meetings helped everyone remain focused on project goals, grant deadlines, and collectively create processes for communications and data collection to jumpstart community efforts.

Individual demonstration communities were also active within their communities during this quarter. Communities reviewed routes for the environmental assessment and continued planning sessions to identify issues and strategies to deal with those issues.

Our private partner and sub-recipient, CCI Systems continued conversations with third party providers. We also executed the sub-contract with CCI Systems for the project. Further, we executed the sub-contract with another partner and sub-recipient, WiscNet.

In addition, National Telecommunications and Information Administration approved our six-month budget. Agreement was obtained and approval given to resolve issues with potential overlap among three different Building Community Capacity through Broadband grants in the Superior Area. We have also launched our website, broadband.uwex.edu, to improve communications with communities, vendors, and partners.

Jobs created this quarter is 1.5.

Our biggest hurdle is clearly the delay in the Finding of No Significant Impact as the programmatic agreement is being finalized

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between the Wisconsin State Historic Preservation Officer, the National Telecommunications and Information Administration, the University of Wisconsin Extension and the Ho Chunk Nation. Despite the dedicated efforts of many, this continues to be a slow process that threatens to put us significantly behind schedule.

1. Please describe significant project accomplishments planned for completion during the next quarter (600 words or less).

At this time we are still waiting for the environmental assessment Finding of No Significant Impact before we can start our project in full. The delay in the Finding of No Significant Impact currently has our project behind schedule by five weeks. Once we get the Finding of No Significant Impact and can proceed with the project, we expect to assign additional construction crews to get us back on schedule. Availability of such crews has been confirmed.

We expect to have a significant start on installation of the long haul fiber and begin installation in all four communities. The wireless services pilot for public safety and education institutions will also begin in this quarter. Procurement and hiring processes are already underway and should be concluded in this quarter with vendor selection, contracts and job offers. Some of these costs were contained in the 6 month budget, such as the first order of fiber optic cable, but most will wait until the Finding of No Significant Impact is in hand. Permitting and engineering work has been proceeding as planned and should continue through the quarter so that fiber installation may begin as soon as possible after the Finding of No Significant Impact is delivered.
