The accomplishment was significant since the initial awarded engineering firm withdrew after because of the strict implementation timelines imposed under the RFP. BBCOM accepted the conditions of the timeline and are proceeding ahead of projected schedules. The engineers confirmed the initial submitted design and budget estimates as being a valid design with proper budget allocations for the project. The engineers also researched and confirmed possible alternative construction plans which, if implemented, will improve the overall capacity of the installed network without changing the overall scope of the project.

As noted above, our initial awarded engineering firm withdrew as they were concerned with the strict timelines. As this occurred during the holiday period, switching to a new firm delayed progress. The current engineers are making excellent progress with the design of the routes and preparation of the bid packages. We are, however, very concerned about the environmental assessments as we see the various parties from whom we need approvals are not responding in a timely manner. We designed the project route to utilize existing highway right of ways where there should be minimal environmental question, but we are concerned the environmental review may be the single point of delay in construction and implementation of the project. Any assistance BTOP can provide to expedite this process will be helpful.
