The participants have the abilities to achieve a nationally-recognized Comp TIA A+ Certification to enhance career advancement.

#### Job Creation:

- -The Maintenance of Broadband (MOB) Squad ended on June 30, 2013. The participating residents gained confidence in obtaining future employment in the field of technology, and were able to experience situations from an end user perspective. They also were able to perform routine maintenance on equipment to determine when and what kind of maintenance is needed, and use logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems. Overall, the MOB Program was successful.
