Once broadband inquiries are received across the state, this information is overlaid with the broadband availability information which was collected through the State Broadband Initiatives (SBI) program. This allows for a real-world comparison of the broadband landscape to the information received from broadband inquiries.									
Broadband inquiries are able to provide three types of information: 1) residents who do not have broadband but want it; 2) residents who have broadband but want a different provider; and 3) residents who do not have broadband, but the broadband inventory maps indicate that they do. If residents within a region state that they are without broadband, but the broadband inventory maps show otherwise, this allows Connected Nation to approach the providers within that area in an effort to trim down their coverage to more accurately represent real-world availability on the ground.

If yes, please list Mapping: During the second quarter of 2011, Connect Florida contacted its identified viable Florida broadband providers (77 as of 30) in an effort to obtain new and updated data. Additionally, five new providers were identified (AreYouOnline.Net, Broadband So Long Hammock Wireless, SkyNet360, and SVIC Internet & Computers) and data were received from one first-time participant. General reseller data was also sought for inclusion in the October 2011 submission. Connect Florida began downloading and processing 2010 census block and road data in May. Twenty-three (23) additional field validation tests were performed during the quarter against six broadband providers (AT&T Inc., Clearwire Corporation, T-Mobile USA Inc., Verizon Florida LLC, Sprint Nextel Corporation, and airPowered) yielding a project-to-date validation percentage of 20.78% in the State of Florida. Follow-up with Community Anchor Institutions (CAIs) that participated in the initial submission to NTIA continued with a focus on schools. Data received from CAIs were quality-checked, refined, geocoded, and prepared as appropriate. Lastly, the residential survey was developed and deployed. 10bb.
