One specific example was the Rural Futures video that highlights the importance of broadband technology and can be viewed at broadband.nebraska.gov. Event Anecdotes include: Nebraska state partner provider of emergency shelter for children in at-risk situations used mapping capabilities to evaluate new sites for agency homes. Reliable Broadband Internet critical to connect agency, site, Child Protective Services and law enforcement for safety, security of at risk children.

• Technical Assistance:

o Regional Workshops – The Western Regional Planning Team hosted the Accelerating Collaboration Summit in Q2. Tourism was identified as an industry that can be strengthened by taking further advantage of broadband at a day long planning session in the Western region of Nebraska. Over 40 leaders, including representatives from broadband providers, nonprofit, university and government participated in the May planning session process that focused on how broadband can be leveraged to increase economic development and improve quality of life.

o Best Practice Videos - Seven interviews conducted in Q2. Success stories include a precision manufacturing company located in a town of 1,700 people that is aerospace certified and services a global market. The company's network administrator/technical support person teleworks 3 weeks a month.
