## 11b. Describe any challenges encountered with vendors or subrecipients.

No challenges with vendors have been identified at this time with the exception of those noted in the Address Project update whereby four counties have currently chosen not to sign contracts or receive funding for address points associated with the Project. Two of these counties anticipate cooperating with the Project's effort to build a statewide address point data layer without executing a contract or receiving funding. One county may yet provide the data if AGRC is able to establish an alternate point of contact that will be willing to develop and share data. And one county has declined to sign the contract and AGRC is attempting to identify an alternate method for developing the data. Please note the Subcontracts table has changed since the Q3 2012 Performance Progress Report submittal and reflects Award Amendment No. 9 having an effective date of November 8, 2012. Unless definitely known, all of the contracts list an end date of the termination date of the Award. The Broadband Project Team recognizes that all work under the Award must be completed by that time. As the end date of the Award draws nearer, more definitive end dates for each contract reflecting when final work products have been provided by the vendors will be know and reported in the Quarterly Performance Progress Report.
