Travel: For each trip list the program purpose of the trip, destination city and the number of people traveling. For each line item (*e.g.*, trip), note the number of trips and the cost per trip. Rather, the *total* trip cost should be derived from the number of trips *times* the justifiable cost per trip.

Supplies: Separate supplies by item type, describing the program purpose or use. For each line item, note the number of units and the unit costs. The multiple of these two factors will yield the total for that line item. For example, an Applicant planning to buy 20 boxes of printer paper at \$30/box would have a total cost of \$600. Other: Separate item types; for awareness program cost items, such as ads, separate ad type (radio, newspaper, etc) and include geography in which they will run.
