On Monday June 27, 2011, Columbia County released Bid# 2010-035 Installation of Fiber Optic Cable Phase VI. This bid will consist of connecting anchor tenants from the inner and/or outer fiber rings, node cabinets, electronic racks, DC Power plant and patch panels. The bid was released to the 25 pre qualified vendors approved by the Board of Commissioners. The bidder will supply majority materials and all labor for bid.

On Monday July 11, 2011, Columbia County released RFP 2011-052 Fiber Restoration and Maintenance Service seeking proposals from qualified Proposers to provide fiber emergency restoration and maintenance services necessary to maintain approximately 200 miles of fiber optic cable and conduit infrastructure.

On Monday July 11, 2011, Columbia County released RFP 2011-053 Managed Network Operations Services seeking proposals from qualified Proposers to manage and monitor the network operations needs of the middle mile network.

On Monday August 8, 2011, Columbia County released RFP 2011-060: Carrier Ethernet Infrastructure seeking proposals from qualified Proposers to provide equipment and services necessary to implement a carrier class Ethernet network.

On Monday August 8, 2011, Columbia County released RFP 2011-061: Router and Firewall Infrastructure seeking proposals from qualified Proposers to provide equipment and services necessary to implement an edge router and firewall solution to complement our carrier class Ethernet network.

On Thursday August 25, 2011, Columbia County received 2 bids for Bid# 2011-035: Installation of Fiber Optic cable – Phase VI. Gibson Technical Services, Inc. from Canton GA was low bidder. Bids ranged from \$1,768,118.00 - \$2,866,800.727.
