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Project Indicators (This Quarter)

1. Please describe significant project accomplishments completed during this quarter (600 words or less).

During this quarter, Quarter 4 of 2011, Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. selected Turnkey Network Solutions for the project through the Construction Request for Proposal (RFP).

The coordination with Merit Networks on its Round 1 award also continued this quarter in regards to the joint build approach for the two National Telecommunications and Information Administration awards. Merit's contractor installed a total of 8,500 feet of conduit in the Bloomingdale joint build area this quarter. In addition, there were meetings with Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. and the City of South Haven to continue discussions of the project.

Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. is still in the process of developing a sub-recipient contract with Great Lakes Comnet where Bloomingdale can construct and Great Lakes Comnet can lease certain project network facilities to connect Bloomingdale's project from Hartford to Berrien Springs, Michigan. This will allow Bloomingdale's middle mile Van Buren Independent School District data network to connect with regional school resources in Berrien Springs. Further, Great Lakes will lease additional fibers on other project routes, creating more efficiencies for both Bloomingdale and Great Lakes and providing greatly improved broadband services for the entire region.

Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. worked on the Rights of Way and Construction permits for this project this quarter and has all of the county road, drain, and soil erosion permits ready. They are still working on the state highway and railroad permits, however there is plenty of time since construction will not start till spring of 2012. Turnkey is ready to start the Amtrak training and the CSX policy should be in soon.

Bloomingdale Communications worked on related Davis Bacon items with Turnkey.

Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. started taking delivery of the fiber optic cable this quarter. Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. received 24 out of the 26 reels ordered, therefore the majority of the order was delivered. The fiber optic cable is included in the construction portion of project budget.

The single fiber vendor selected in 2nd Quarter of 2011 was Power & Telephone. Vantage Point Solutions, the selected engineering firm, also continued to work with Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. in regards to the project.

The number of jobs created or retained in the 4th Quarter of 2011 was 0.52 full time equivalent. Bloomingdale Communications, Inc. drew down \$277,025.41 in federal funds in the 4th quarter of 2011.
