- 1) The OCAN project has the ability to form partnerships with telecommunication companies that wish to participate in this endeavor to expand broadband to Oklahoma's rural areas.
- 2) Allows access to basic services in the most remote areas of the state and bring an estimated 863 new jobs to Oklahoma.
- 3) In addition to the 32 Community Anchor Institutions that will be connected to the network in the initial construction, projections reflect that 10 new anchors will be added every year, resulting in a total of 84 connected institutions by year 8.
- 4) 827 miles of new fiber construction completed the total 2,221 mile OCAN route reaching 35 counties, 17 tribal jurisdictions and impacting 89% of Oklahoma's population.
- 5) The OCAN project expended 97.58 percent of Federal funds by grant closeout end.

As each of the twenty-one grant construction projects complete ODOT'S internal audit and closeout, ODOT submits invoices for reimbursement from the grant.
