The final site within Adams County, located at the Adcom911 facility, was completed, and drive tests were performed by General Dynamics. Adcom911 accepted the results, and the original General Dynamics contract was completed and closed out. Adcom911 continued to work with Denver International Airport (DIA) to obtain permitting for the three sites on DIA property. Adcom911 submitted a request to extend the Grant deadline until August 31st 2015, this request was approved. Adcom911 completed backhaul configuration for the link between Adcom and the State of New Mexico to allow their Radio Access Network (RAN) to associate with the Adcom core. Significant progress was made on the Service Level Agreement, and Intergovernmental Agreement designating Adcom as the LTE core provider for New Mexico.
