The project milestones for Leading Practices activities have now been planned out. For more details, please refer to the Q1 Supplemental Answers Document.
10bb. Please describe any challenge or obstacle that you have encountered and detail the mitigation strategies the project team is employing There are two challenges noted within this quarter's activities: (Some are the same as previous, looking to NTIA/FCC for support)
1) With the verification efforts continuing, there's a challenge balancing conflicts identified during the verification process and requesting updates or correctness in data collected/reported by the provider. Need to ensure the map is an accurate representation of broadband availability, but also need to ensure cooperativeness of the providers themselves.
2) Address/Basemap Data - It's been noticed by Providers and public users that geocoding on the State map is not locating some of their addresses. This is the major feedback being received through the feedback collection tool (Crowd Sourcing) on the interactive map. This is due to the address data available for the State, as many street level data does not have detailed and current address-level data in rural areas. Mississippi did request grant approval for a Master Address File to build up a stronger basemap, which would help alleviate this challenge, but funding was denied.
3) The last challenge is the 2nd priority feedback item on the interactive map, where provider coverage displayed is being questioned by the public as it represents either too generalized of a footprint (census block) or is completely missing as resellers are not included. Need support from NTIA/FCC on future model changes to incorporate better requirements for reseller and business-only providers. 10cc.
