REASON(S) FOR AMENDMENT
 This Grant is hereby amended to provide additional Federal funding in the amount of \$1,714,652.00 to complete a project to map broadband availability for five (5) years and engage in broadband planning activities for five(5) years for the US Virgin Islands, pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and the Broadband Data Improvement Act. Awards made pursuant to the State Broadband Data and Development Grant Program are available only to the single eligible entity designated by each State.  ALL PREVIOUS TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT.

6. Funding Clause

This amendment provides \$1,714,652.00 in additional Federal funds for the continued funding of this multi-year award for a total of \$3,009,506.00, for the Recipient's implementation of the State Broadband Data and Development Program activities described in the Recipient's application and proposal dated June 30, 2010 and revision dated August 5, 2010. The overall award period for this action will extend from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2014. The Department of Commerce is not liable for any obligations, expenditures, or commitments which involve any amount in excess of the Federal amount presently available.

18. The Recipient shall be required to adhere to guidelines issued by NTIA regarding state broadband maps, associated content and websites or other publicly distributed materials, and provide notifications to NTIA before making substantial changes to any of the above materials.
19. In the event that program objectives in regard to data collection can no longer be achieved, the recipient may be allowed to modify its project proposal or terminate the project.
20. The Recipient has agreed to utilize a methodology that has been reviewed by external subject matter experts for the purpose of calculating households served by broadband within a given geography, and, where appropriate, to use the related questions found in the American Community Survey conducted by the Bureau of the Census.
21. Federal fund in excess of \$50,000 will not be released for all projects approved under this Amendment until NTIA has reviewed and approved a revised and detailed project plan, timeline and cost estimates, Awardees must submit these items within 120 days from the date of this Amendment, but may do so earlier. Revised budgets for data collection and related activities must include no more than a ten percent of the total five-year mapping

budget costs as a line-item to support the implementation of future, and currently unidentified, leading practices. Federal funds for this line item will not be released until NTIA has reviewed and approved the use of the funds. Notwithstanding the above, federal funds for all contracts expected to be in excess of \$100,000 will not be released until the Scope of Work, cost estimates and contractor qualifications are reviewed and approved by NTIA. Additionally, Awardee must provide to NTIA for review and approval job descriptions for new employees expected to be paid \$100,000 per year or more before Federal funding supporting these positions is released.

22. The awarding agency has the right to: 1) obtain, reproduce, publish or otherwise use data first produced under an award; and 2) authorize others to received reproduce, publish or otherwise use such data for federal purposes. (Before authorizing others to use the material, a determination must be made that the use for a federal purpose) except as otherwise specifically provided under an award, authors may copyright any work that is subject to copyright and was developed under an award. When claim is made to copyright, the applicable copyright notice of 17 U.S.C. 401 or 402 and acknowledgment of Federal government, is published, or is deposited for registration as a published work in the U.S. Copyright office. The copyright owner shall grant to the Federal government, and others acting on its behalf, a paid up, nonexclusive, irrevocable, worldwide license for all such works to reproduce, publish, or otherwise use the work of Federal government purposes. 23. Awardees also receiving Broadband Technology Opportunities Program (BTOP) awards shall not utilize funds BTOP and SBDD funds for the identical activity.
